



SENIOR CONSULTANT ON HEALTH AND CLIMATE CHANGE

Remote

The Green Climate Fund (“GCF”) is a multilateral fund created to make a significant and ambitious contribution to the global efforts towards attaining the goals set by the international community to combat climate change. GCF is governed by a Board, composed of an equal representation of developed and developing countries. The Fund is operated by an independent Secretariat headed by an Executive Director. The Fund will contribute to the achievement of the ultimate objective of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). In the context of sustainable development, the Fund will promote the paradigm shift towards low-emission and climate-resilient development pathways by providing support to developing countries to limit or reduce their greenhouse gas emissions and to adapt to the impacts of climate change, taking into account the needs of those developing countries particularly vulnerable to the adverse effects of climate change.

Role

The GCF is seeking a senior consultant (“the Consultant”) to provide support to the Secretariat’s work related to health and climate change. He/she should lead and significantly contribute to the development and review of health and well-being strategic guide and other relevant work.

The Consultant will support the work of various technical papers for the health and well-being result area of the GCF, including assignments under the Communities of Practice scope of work by the Firm. He/she will coordinate the assignment and will provide feedback to the selected consulting firm on the expected deliverables and finalization of work, if necessary. He/she will also be responsible for attending the relevant consultations/validation for on the sector technical papers and facilitation of the process, as well as planning and organizing workshop(s).

The contract will be of 6-month period. The position is home-based and will require regular teleconference with the GCF staff based in Songdo during Korea business hours. The position might require travel.

Duties and responsibilities

Under the guidance of the Health and Well-being Specialist, the consultant will undertake the following tasks:

- 1) Provide advice on the strategic matters related to health, well-being and climate change
- 2) Facilitate consultations with relevant stakeholders on the strategic papers prepared on the matters related to health and climate change
- 3) Analyse how health and well-being can be strengthened as a result area of the Fund
- 4) Join meetings (remote is possible) for calls with the Firm that drafts the Strategic Guide and provide input and guidance to ensure the guide addresses all related matters in adaptation and mitigation for GCF



- 5) If available, incorporate the output of the Well-being Consultant into the guide to make it complete and fluent, filling in gaps where appropriate
- 6) Finalise the Strategic Guide for the Health and Well-being Sector ready for print (prior to graphic design and proof reading)
- 7) Any other tasks as requested by the Health and Well-being specialist

Required experience and qualifications

- a) PhD degree in Environmental science, preferably, in Public Health or Epidemiology studies or a post-graduate degree with a focus on Epidemiology would be an advantage;
- b) At least 20 years of experience with international organizations, and/or non-governmental organization and/or private sector and/or academia in evaluation, review and strategic matters related to health and climate change;
- c) Experience with research and publication, in particular, on impacts of climate change on health and well-being;
- d) Experience in developing countries on various adaptation topics, including vulnerability assessments, is preferred;
- e) Experience in facilitating consultations and workshops would be an asset;
- f) Fluency in English is essential; knowledge of another UN is an advantage.
