Status of the GCF portfolio: pipeline and approved projects

Summary

This document provides an update of the GCF portfolio, including the pipeline of projects and programmes for the reporting period of 16 May to 20 August 2017.




I. Status of the funding proposal pipeline

- 1. At its eleventh meeting, the Board requested the Secretariat to provide an update of the pipeline portfolio and to submit it for information to the Board as part of the documentation submitted for every Board meeting. This status report responds to the Board's request and provides an update for the reporting period of 16 May to 20 August 2017.
- 2. As at 20 August 2017, the GCF pipeline comprised 74 public- and private-sector funding proposals, which request a total GCF funding of USD 3.8 billion to support projects and programmes totalling USD 13.9 billion, when taking co-financing into account.²




Figure 2. Regional distribution of the requested amount of GCF funding

- Table 1 presents the overview of the pipeline, broken down into different sectors, and figure 1 presents the status of the funding proposals in the pipeline with respect to their level of progress in the GCF due-diligence process. The geographical distribution of the pipeline is presented in figure 2 and 3.

Figure 1. Status of funding proposal progress





Figure 4. Total requested GCF amount by financial instrument





Figure 5. Total requested GCF amount by theme




Figure 6. Requested GCF funding by results areas (percentage)

6. The climate impact potential of the pipeline in terms of the contribution to GCF core indicators is presented in figure 7.

Based on the level of advancement of each funding proposal,³ it is estimated, at this juncture, that 59 projects and programmes within the pipeline are expected to be presented to the Board within the next 12 months, with a total requested GCF funding of USD 2.7 billion supporting projects and programmes worth USD 7.8 billion. The list of these projects and programmes, as well as an additional list of the other funding proposals in the pipeline at different stages of the review process are presented in annex I. Many of the submitted funding proposals were drawn from the country programme briefs and entity work programmes, the status of which is also presented in annex I.

II. Status of the direct access entity pipeline

8. As at the reporting date, the GCF pipeline for direct access entities is shown in table 2:

- The Secretariat continues to work closely with direct access entities and national designated authorities (NDAs)/focal points in developing their pipelines of proposals to be submitted to the GCF. As at the reporting date, 29 requests for Project Preparation Facility (PPF) support have been officially submitted with no-objection letters, of which two have been approved and one is under implementation. Of the 29 PPF requests, ten are from direct access entities. The list of these PPF requests, including those approved, is presented in annex II.
- The Secretariat is undertaking a series of actions to substantially increase the quantity and pace of approvals for PPF support, which are detailed in document GCF/B.18/09 titled "Considerations of accreditation proposals". Furthermore, as at the reporting date, requests for readiness support were approved for four direct access entities to strengthen their capacity in developing their pipeline and effective monitoring and oversight of the approved projects.⁴

III. Status of the concept note pipeline

11. As at the reporting date, the GCF pipeline for concept notes is shown in table 3:

- Among the 109 concept notes, five proposals request PPF support. There are also eight enhanced direct access proposals requesting GCF funding of USD 133 million.
- Figures 8 and 9 present the geographical and thematic distribution of the requested GCF funding for the concept notes.



IV. Status of the knowledge management development

4.1 Status update

- By decision B.17/09, annex III, the Board requested the Secretariat to develop an online concept note and funding proposal submission portal and improve data management and analytics, for example the accredited entity (AE) submission portal and NDA portal. It also requested the Secretariat to provide an updated note on proactive pipeline management and related knowledge management by the eighteenth meeting of the Board. This section responds to the Board requests.
- The Secretariat has been developing pipeline and portfolio management systems since the project review started in 2015. Significant improvement was made when excel-based data management was evolved into a cloud-based system called "Integrated Portfolio Management System" in May 2016. The system began with a few basic modules for entering key information on concept notes and funding proposals, and continued to be improved. Currently the system handles most of the GCF internal knowledge management to implement project operations, and analyse and display business processes data in dashboards and reports, including the life cycles, key dates, conditions of approved projects, disbursements, accreditation master agreement status and AE accreditation condition.
- Given the growing demands and challenges in relation to the database such as quality, transparency and the absence of advanced analytical tools, the Secretariat started strategic planning in developing an AE and NDA portal in late April 2017.
- As part of the preparation for the AE and NDA portal, the Secretariat performed data cleansing for both public and private sector proposals. On the public-sector side, this exercise was performed between May and July 2017 in communication with each AE and NDA. AEs and NDAs were requested to verify whether proposals that had not made progress for a certain period of time would be kept in the GCF pipeline. As a result, a total of 138 proposals were removed from the pipeline: 42 project ideas, 88 concept notes and 8 funding proposals. Of these removed proposals, 76 were classified as "withdrawn", as verified by AEs and NDAs, and 62 were made "inactive", as there had been no communication from AEs/NDAs for the past two years.



- On the private sector side, a total of 15 proposals (10 concept notes and 5 funding proposals) were removed from the pipeline as a result of the data cleansing exercise, which was performed between May and August 2017 in communication with each AE. Of these removed proposals, 10 were classified as "withdrawn", as verified by the AEs, and 5 were made "inactive" as there had been no communication from the AEs for the past two years.
- 19. Withdrawn or inactive concept notes or proposals can be added to the pipeline again anytime upon resubmission by AEs.

4.2 Strategies for proactive pipeline management and related knowledge management

The Board has been constantly requesting the Secretariat to enhance the quality and transparency of the project pipeline by providing access to an advanced knowledge management system to relevant stakeholders, such as AEs and NDAs. In an effort to meet this request, the Secretariat is further developing the system in collaboration with third-party service providers.

4.3 Portals for accredited entities and national designated authorities

- The Secretariat plans to launch the first version of the AE and NDA portal by the end of 2017. It will enable the AEs and NDAs to access the GCF data repository of their project pipeline, which includes the status of the concept notes and funding proposals submitted. Prior to the official launching of the portal, the Secretariat shared the pilot version with a number of AEs and NDAs in September 2017 to test the system and receive their feedback in order to improve the ergonomics of the user interface and to resolve any potential issues raised.
- The Secretariat aims to have the second version of the portal ready during the second quarter of 2018, in particular with the feature of online concept note and funding proposal submission. The procurement process is under way with professional services and technologies.
