GCF's response to COVID-19

GCF recognises that the COVID-19 outbreak is serious and takes responsibility for protecting its staff and ensuring the continuity of its operations. GCF remains open for business. All our operations continue, we continue to work to deliver on our mandate.

We have put in place measures to reduce the risk of infection at our headquarters, in light of the incidence of COVID-19 in the Republic of Korea. We have also moved to allow many staff to work remotely, often from their home countries, whilst maintaining core staff in Songdo. Remote working is part of our normal working practices, this is an extension rather than a new practice.

There are an increasing number of international travel restrictions, and as such we are reducing our business travel to a minimum. We are not participating in international conferences at this stage or organising public events, and are conducting virtual meetings wherever possible.

As participants have been informed, we have taken the step of moving the venue of our [B.25 Board meeting to Geneva](#).

We ask for the patience of our partners if our responses take longer than expected during this period.
