During both sessions, participants were oriented on the ESMP, and Urdu versions of the ESMP and LRP were provided to the General Body members of the Burzwali CBO. In total, 29 community members (15 male and 14 female) participated in the in-person disclosure meetings held in Village Burzwali.
