WHAT IS IRMF AND WHY IRMF?



Integrated Results Management Framework

What:

IRMF is the **GCF's umbrella results framework** to monitor, analyze, and report on the aggregated, portfolio-wide results of the Fund's investments.

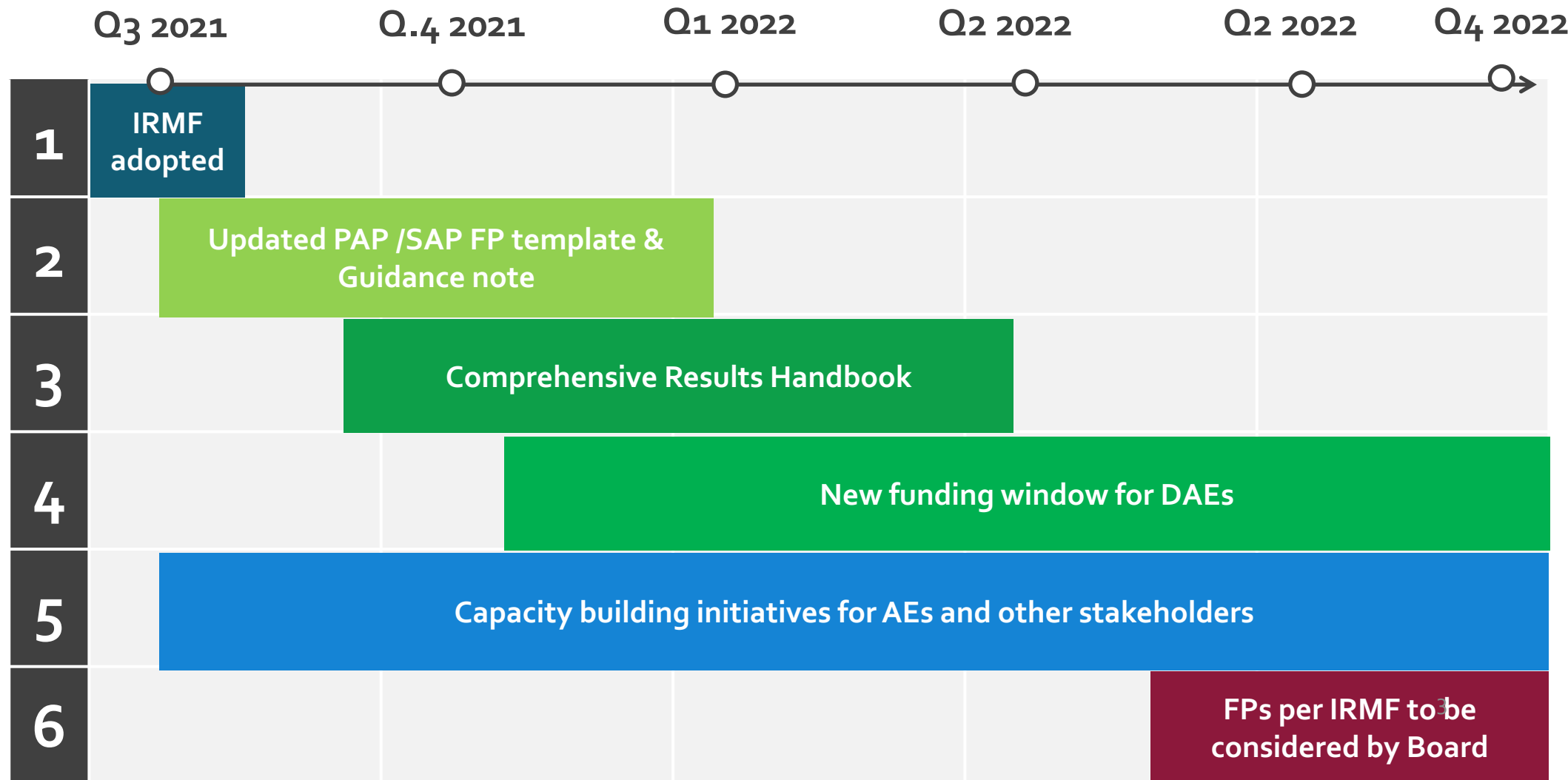
Why:

The IRMF aims to establish clear definitions and methodologies for GCF's priority indicators and monitoring and assessment processes to ensure that GCF-funded activities apply the same approach and generate consistent, robust data that can be aggregated and compared across the entire GCF portfolio.



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TIMELINE OF IRMF IMPLEMENTATION



NEW GCF FUNDING WINDOW TO SUPPORT DAEs WITH IRMF IMPLEMENTATION



UNDER READINESS PROGRAMME

Standard funding window

USD 1 million cap, per country, per year

Additional funding window

Up to USD 0.20 million per DAE, no clearance required by NDAs

GUIDING PRINCIPLES FOR ACCESSING THE NEW FUNDING WINDOW

1

Additional & Relevant

The support provided under this window should be **additional** to the approved readiness support and **relevant** to IRMF implementation

2

Addressing capacity gaps

Proposed activities should aim to enhance preparedness and capacity of DAEs to develop GCF funding proposals in line with the IRMF requirements.

3

List of project ideas or FPs in pipeline

DAEs will be required to provide a list of project ideas and/or funded activity proposals that are in the GCF pipeline.

ELIGIBLE OUTCOMES, ACTIVITIES AND DELIVERABLES

NEW GCF FUNDING WINDOW TO SUPPORT DAEs WITH IRMF IMPLEMENTATION



FUNDING CHANNEL

- Activities to be financed should fall under the **umbrella Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme (RPSP) Strategy**.
- Eligible costs shall cover the activities contributing to strengthening the **monitoring and evaluation capacity** of the accredited DAEs under the IRMF and refining the **pipeline funding proposal(s)** with the IRMF applied.

SCOPE

DAEs can choose from **3 expected outputs developed for this funding window and linked to outcome 1.2 and 4.2** of the RPSP Strategy, depending on their needs. DAEs can propose any **relevant activities and deliverables** in connection to the expected outputs

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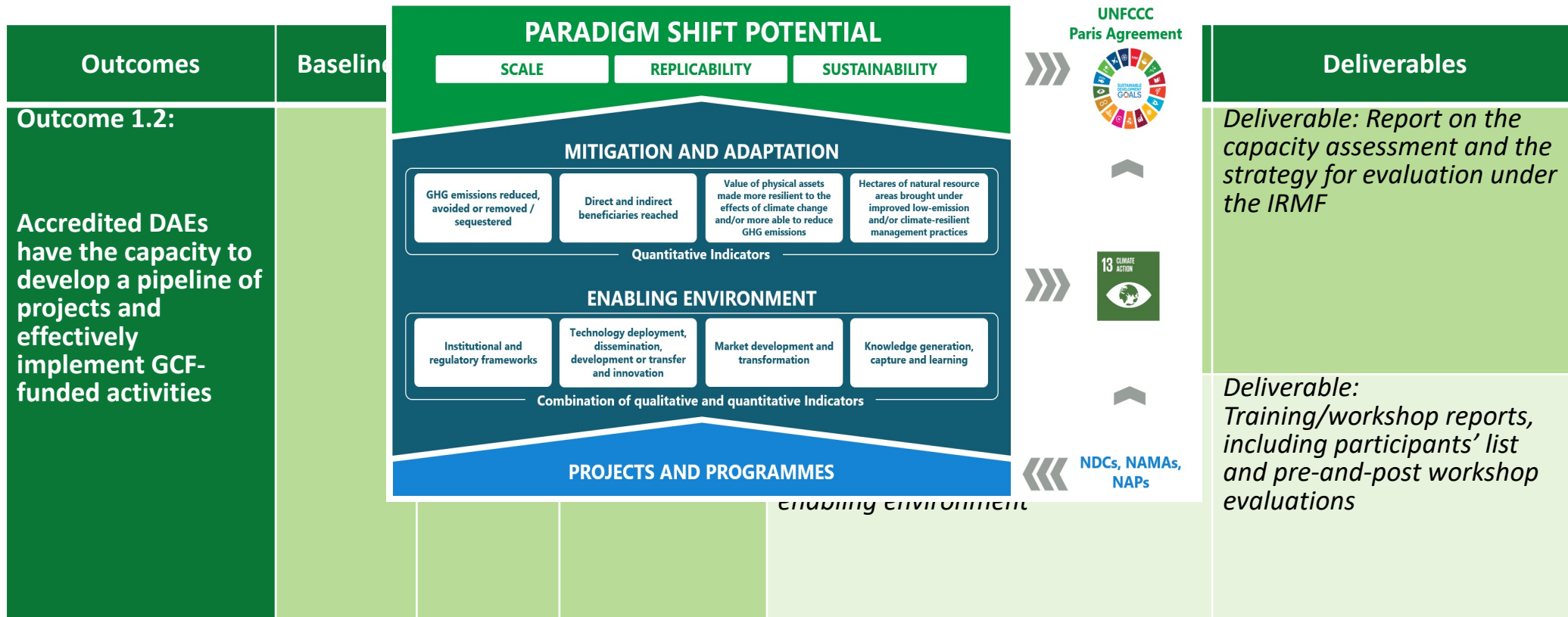

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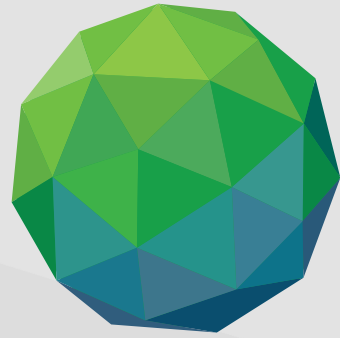
