MODALITY

B.45 will be held as an in-person meeting. In accordance with paragraph 10 of the Governing Instrument for the GCF, if a Board member cannot attend all or part of a meeting of the Board, his or her alternate will attend on his or her behalf, serving as the Board member. In accordance with the Information Disclosure Policy, B.45 will be webcast.

REGISTRATION

Participants can register through the **Online Registration System (ORS)** from **18:00 KST on Monday, 18 May 2026 to 23:59 KST on Monday, 1 June 2026**. For Board members, alternate Board members, and advisers, the ORS is available on the **Board Portal**. Other participants will receive an email with details on how to log in to the system separately.

Registration is required to attend B.45 in person. Those who wish to watch the meeting virtually through the webcast are not required to register.

VISA

Visa-Free Entry (52 countries)

Citizens of eligible countries may enter Tajikistan without a visa for up to 30 days. Countries eligible for visa-free entry: <https://consular.tj/visaarchive/19-nizomi-beravodid.html>

Visa on Arrival (up to 140 countries)

Visa on Arrival is available **only at Dushanbe International Airport** and not at land borders. This option may apply for short stays such as tourism, conferences, or official visits. However, it can be less predictable, therefore obtaining an e-visa is generally recommended.

Apply online before travel

The fee for visa on arrival is **USD10** during the online application process to be paid by card, and **additionally USD40** to be paid **in cash upon arrival** at the airport (please note, the actual additional fee may differ by USD5-10 depending on specific circumstances of the application).

E-Visa (126 countries)

This is generally the most convenient option for participants who require a visa.

Apply online before travel

Valid for up to 90 days, permitted stay up to 60 days

The fee for e-visa is **USD30** to be paid online by card.

Support with visa applications

If a visa is required, the Tajikistan NDA can provide participants with a Visa Support Letter upon request. In such cases, participants are kindly requested to send their request for a visa support letter to Mr. Faromuz Saidov, the NDA focal point for visa-related matters, at faromuzsaidov95@gmail.com, with a copy to cepprj@gmail.com.

Registration with Authorities

Board meeting participants who intend to stay 10 calendar days or longer (this includes visa-free entry, visa on arrival and e-visa) are required to be registered with relevant authorities. Such arrangements will be facilitated by the hotels. If you are staying outside of the Government recommended hotels, please inform faromuzsaidov95@gmail.com.

Transit Visas

Please note that arranging any required transit visas is the responsibility of the participant. Letters of invitation issued by the Secretariat may be used to support visa applications, including transit visas. Letters of invitation are automatically sent to the participant once the registration is confirmed by the Secretariat.

FLIGHTS

The Secretariat will arrange flights for developing country constituency Board members, alternate Board members, and their respective funded advisers. These participants should submit their travel requests after registration through Oracle. The Secretariat kindly requests that all travel requests be submitted via Oracle by **1 June**. All other participants are responsible for booking their flights.

ARRIVAL IN TAJIKISTAN

Participants will arrive in Tajikistan by air at Dushanbe International Airport. Arrival and departure formalities for Board members, alternate members, and advisers will be facilitated by the host country. Further details will be communicated in due course.

Airport transportation and venue transportation will be provided for the hotels included above. Further information will be provided closer to the event.

HEALTH, SAFETY AND SECURITY ASSESSMENT

GCF is informed by its health, safety, and security information provider that medical facilities in Tajikistan, including in Dushanbe, may have variable standards, with public hospitals often limited in resources and capacity. A number of private clinics provide more consistent care; however, overall medical capabilities remain limited compared to international standards.

If medical attention is required, participants are advised to seek care at designated private or internationally referenced facilities in Dushanbe, such as International Clinic Avicenna (Ibn Sina) or Prospekt Medical Clinic. For serious conditions, Istiqlol Hospital is considered the primary tertiary facility for emergency care. Foreign nationals should expect to pay for services upfront and ensure adequate health insurance coverage prior to travel.

Possible health risks include food- and water-borne illnesses, as well as seasonal air quality concerns due to dust and potential sandstorm conditions. Participants are advised to take basic precautions, including consuming safe food and bottled water, maintaining good hygiene, and following guidance related to air quality conditions.

Participants with pre-existing medical conditions or sensitivities should consult their medical practitioner prior to travel and ensure they carry any required medication. Availability of certain medications may be limited locally.

GENERAL INFORMATION

GCF is moving to eliminate the use of disposable plastic water bottles at Board meetings. We encourage all participants to bring their own reusable bottles.

Time zone

Tajikistan Time (TJT) is 5 hours ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC+5).

Weather

Dushanbe has a continental climate with hot, dry summers. In late June and early July, daytime temperatures typically range from around 28°C to 35°C, with warm evenings. Rainfall is minimal during this period, and air quality is generally good.

Dress code

The dress code for the event is smart casual.

Language

All meetings will be conducted in English.

Currency

The unit of currency in Tajikistan is the Tajikistani somoni (TJS)

Electricity

The standard voltage in Tajikistan is 220–230 volts with a frequency of 50 Hz. The outlets are Type C and Type F, which are the same types used in continental Europe and many other countries.
