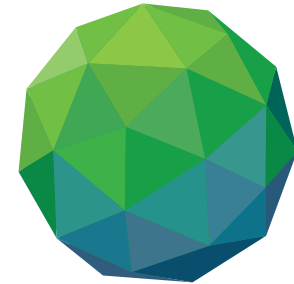

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

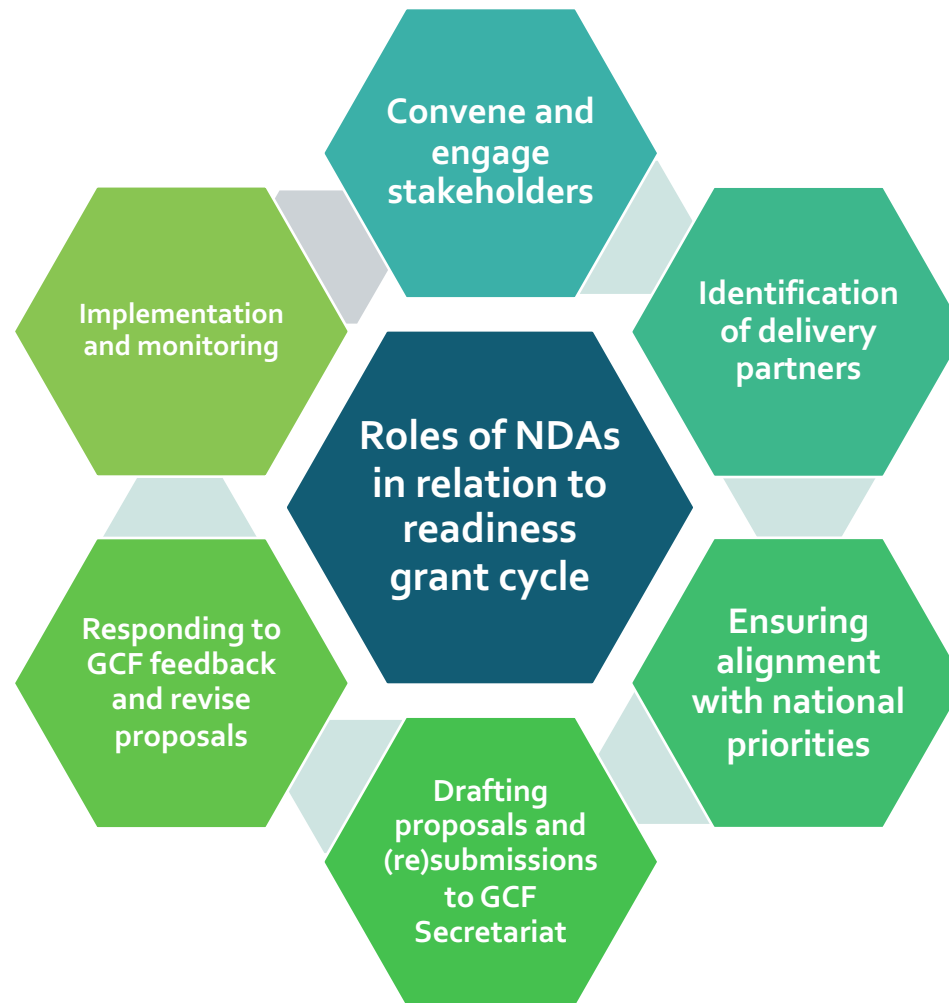
NDA, DELIVERY PARTNER, AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS



- Country ownership - NDAs are in the driving seat
- Delivery Partners support NDAs in delivering the intended outcomes that address the identified gaps
- Other stakeholders such as line ministries, CSOs, community groups, private sector, academia, will be engaged by NDAs and DPs, as appropriate

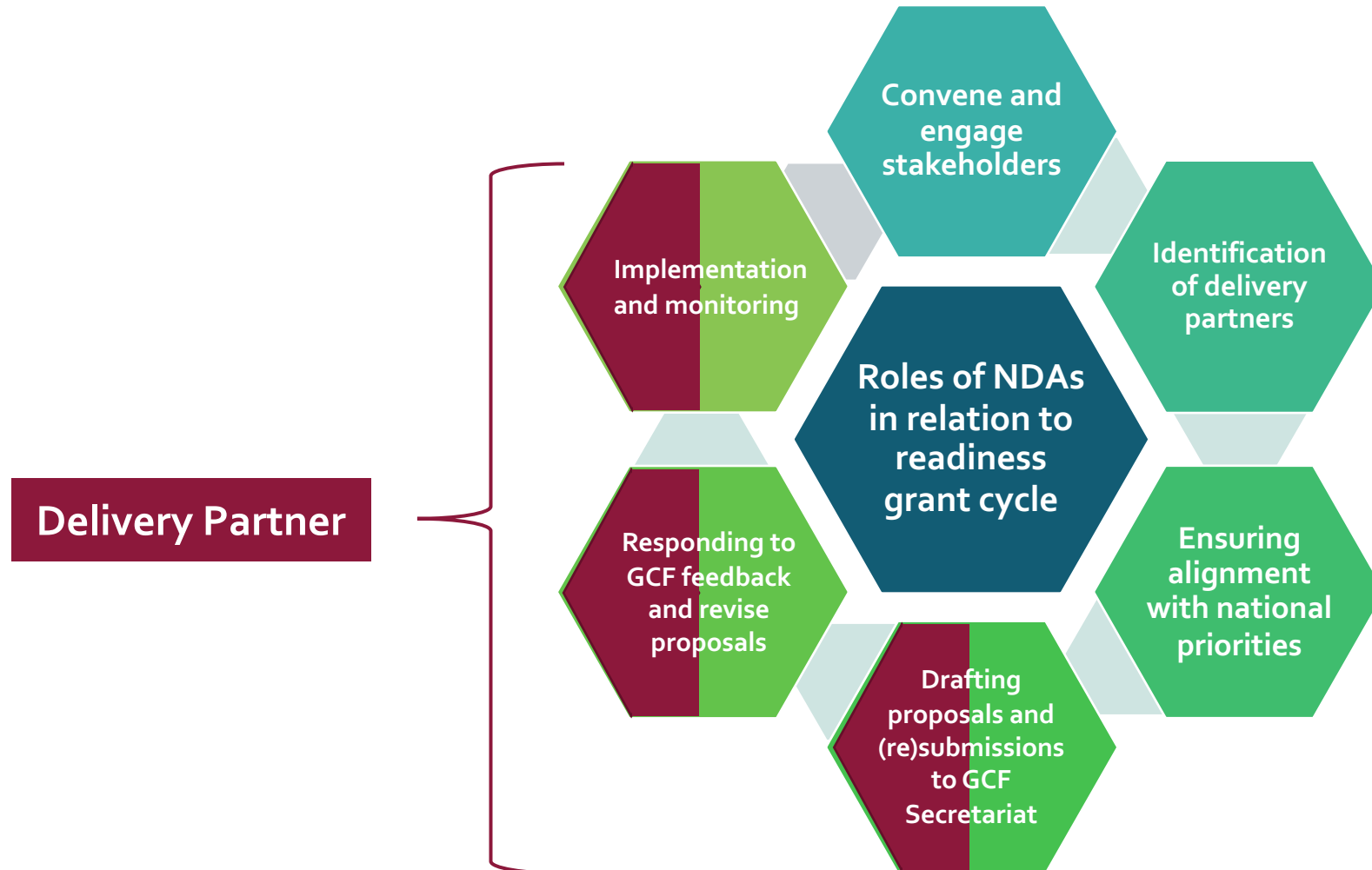
ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DELIVERY PARTNERS



- Institutions selected by the NDA to support the delivery of readiness support.
- Delivery partners provide services such as: development of readiness request proposals in cooperation with NDAs; implementation and supervision; fiduciary management; progress reporting; and project completion and evaluation.
- Delivery partners will have a contractual relationship with GCF and be responsible for the implementation of the readiness support and will carry out all fiduciary and financial management, procurement of goods and services, monitoring and reporting activities.
- Delivery partners may engage implementing partners and pass through funds to a third party but will still be accountable to GCF.

IDENTIFYING SUITABLE DELIVERY PARTNERS

DELIVERY PARTNER OPTIONS



Consideration when selecting delivery partners:

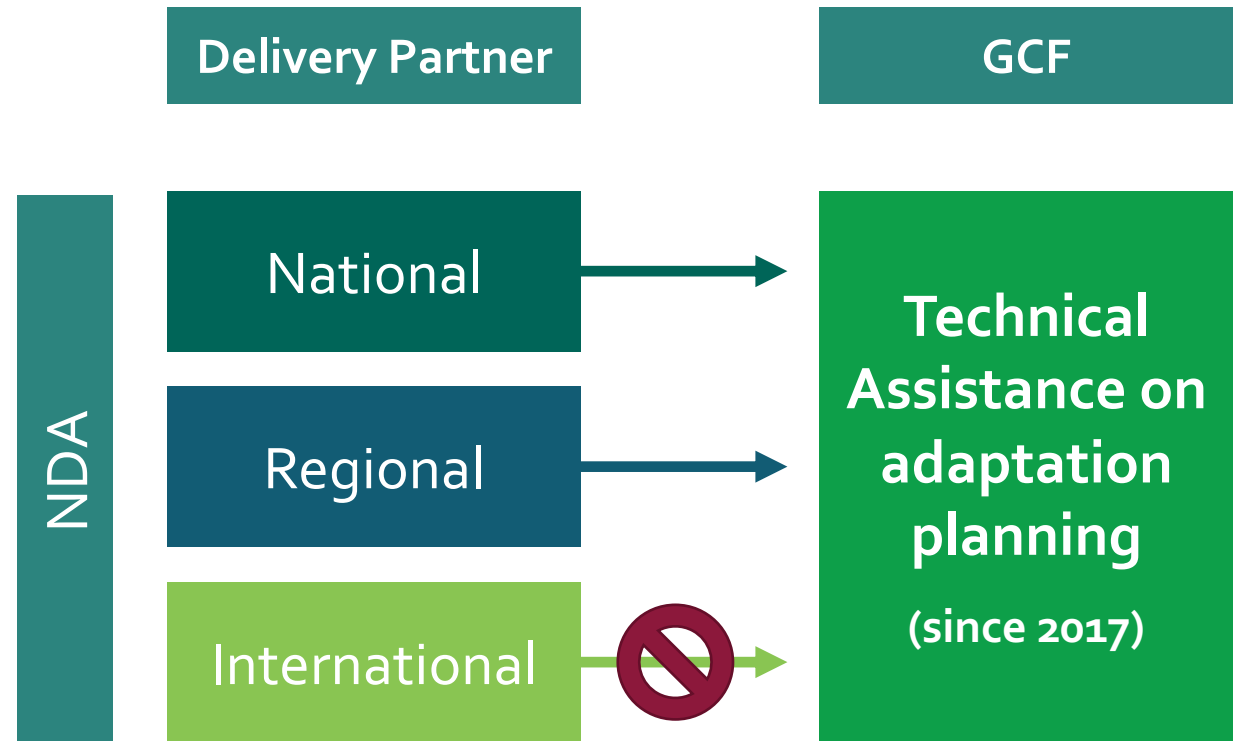
- NDAs should select a Delivery Partner that has the required expertise, skills and relevant experience to successfully contribute to the achievement of intended outcomes.
- Track record of DPs in the country, region and/or the context of proposed interventions (sectoral, sub-national level, etc.)
- Delivery Partner does NOT have to be a GCF Accredited Entity (AE).
- Non-AE requires a **Financial Management Capacity Assessment** in order to become a Delivery Partner.

DELIVERY PARTNER OPTIONS AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE (TA)



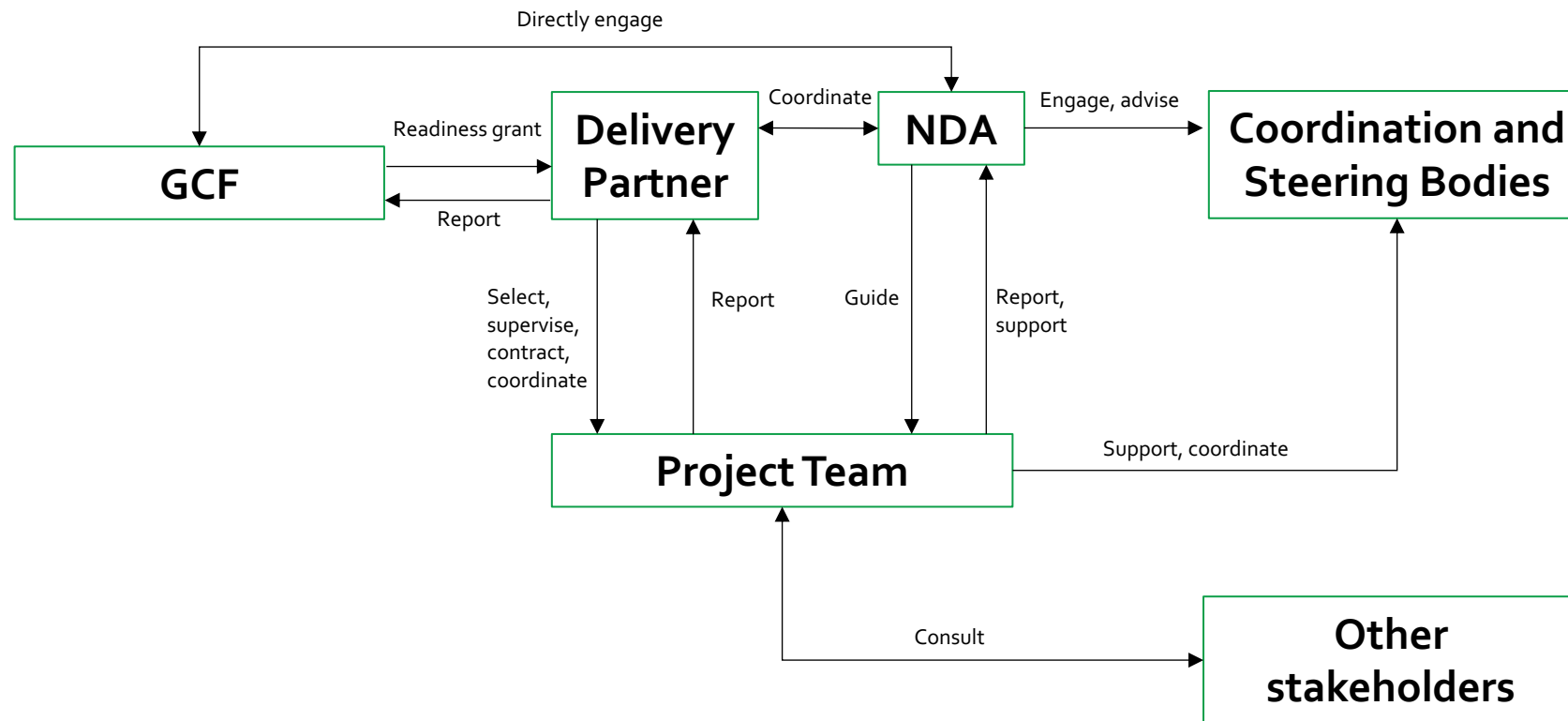
Delivery Partner Options:

- NDAs that work with national or regional DPs can request technical assistance from GCF (at no additional cost).
- NDAs that have not yet decided DPs may also request TA and develop proposals with TA consultants

GCF CO-DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT FOR ADAPTATION PLANNING



Co-development support by regional desks:

- Upstream technical guidance and support to the NDA/DP to ensure the proposal substantially responds to the specific capacity and/or technical gaps and challenges of the country and aligns with the GCF guidelines set out in the Readiness Guidebook.
- Provide useful context for potential proposals, including best practices and lessons learned from other countries and successfully implemented proposals.
- Ensure alignment with national priorities as well as complementarity and coherence with past and ongoing support funded by other donors as well as previous GCF readiness support

GCF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR ADAPTATION PLANNING



Technical Assistance includes:

- Deployed directly in countries (post-pandemic) and work face-to-face with NDAs (and DPs) and other stakeholders
- Guiding the country to design key elements of adaptation planning requests such as Logical Framework and Theory of Change
- Reviewing the requests and other relevant documents prepared by NDAs (and DPs)
- Attending meetings with relevant stakeholders
- Support drafting actual proposals
- Provide inputs to other elements of proposals
