GCF support to the CPDAE

GCF vision of CPDAE initiative

- Support CPDAE to **strengthen capacity building support** and **accelerate direct access to climate finance** for developing countries
- **AF/GCF are active observers** to CPDAE and fully committed to supporting the planned activities.

GCF/AF joint support to the CPDAE

- GCF and AF are supporting the CPDAE according to a **mandate to enhance GCF's complementarity and coherence.**
- GCF supported the **establishment of the CPDAE** and its Managing Committee, Action Plan, and Governance Chapter **in two meetings** in South Africa (June 2019) and Antigua and Barbuda (August 2019)
- GCF **supports the CPDAE to access the Readiness Program** to assist in the implementation of its Action Plan



Direct access in the GCF context

USP 2020 – 2023:

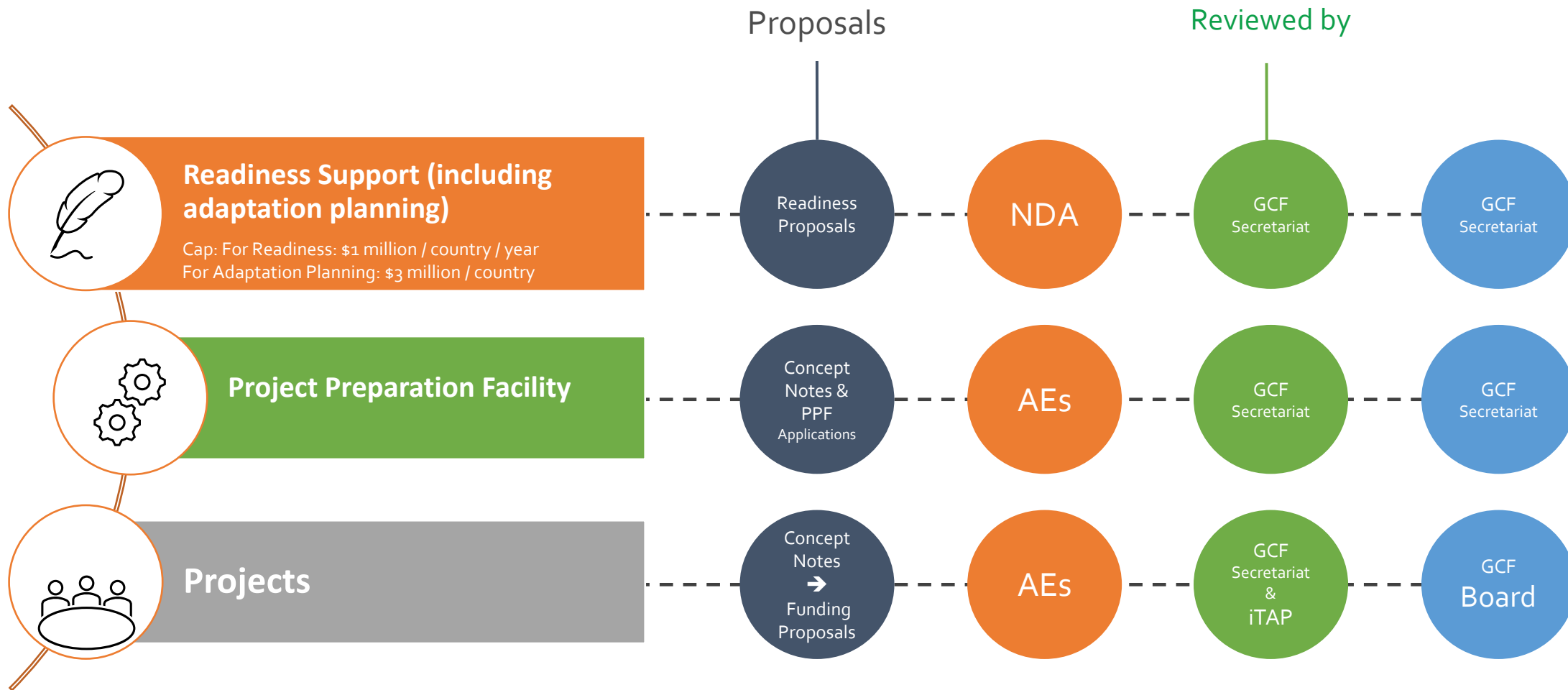
- GCF-1 programming period: **“significantly increase funding channeled through DAEs”**
- GCF USP: **continue to support capacity-building for NDAs and DAEs**
- Advance **“programming synergies with other climate funds”**

CPDAE can strengthen country ownership:

- Building the programming and implementation **capabilities of DAEs**
- Supporting DAEs to play a more prominent role in GCF programming and **channel significantly more GCF funding**

Background

- CPDAE has established a governance framework, including :
 - The development of the CPDAE Charter of Governance,
 - The establishment of the CPDAE Committee and the guidelines for the operationalization of CPDAE committee;
- CPDAE has developed an initial action plan;

Gaps

- The lack of capacity to develop high quality concept notes and funding proposals;
- Difficulties in fulfilling the GCF/AF re-accreditation/accreditation upgrade requirements;
- The absence of an appropriate and dedicated tools for knowledge management and lessons-sharing for the Community of Direct Access Entities;
- The lack of specific features in the existing CPDAE governance framework;



Readiness request's objective

The objective of the readiness request is to support the implementation of CPDAE initial action plan. This includes:

- Build the capacity of CPDAE members on various technical issues (M&E, ESS, CN&FP design, re-accreditation/accreditation upgrade);
- Support the update of CPDAE members' projects pipeline;
- Support the enhancement of peer-to-peer dialogue, learning and experience sharing on project origination, development and implementation.
- Strengthen CPDAE's governance framework and coordination mechanism;

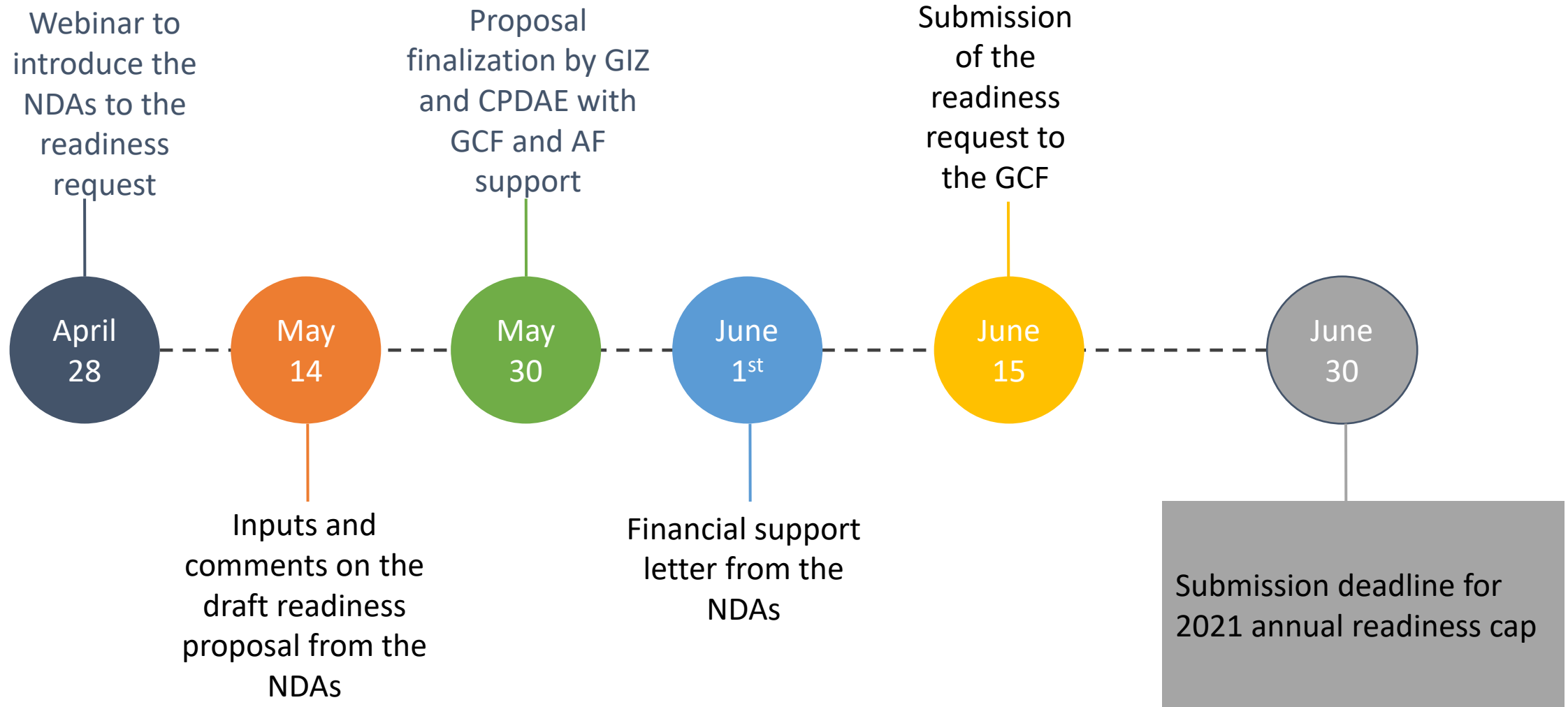
