

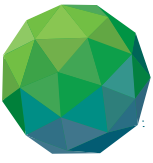
ADDENDUM NO. 2

2.	TECH 2A: Does the page limit apply to all companies in the Consortium or two pages could be used to describe each company?	Part A of Tech-2 applies to the description of overall organization of the firm/consortium, including each associate for this assignment which overall should not exceed two pages.
3.	Please kindly confirm that the 25-30 page limit (Annex 1, 3.2) is applicable to each of the four deliverables and not to the whole methodology.	Yes, the understanding is correct. 25-30-pages limit applies to each of the four deliverables.
4.	FIN 2B: Is it requested to indicate experts' names and positions within or break down by category (e.g. key, support staff)?	The tenderer should indicate the proposed experts' names and positions as well as the category, in relation to this project.
5.	Does the Annex 4 need to be filed by each company in the Consortium?	Annex 4 – Company Profile, should be filed by the main company/contractor of the consortium and the members of the consortium must be mentioned as well. If necessary, the GCF may do reference checks of all the consortium members too.
6.	Annex 3(C) – Evaluation of Technical Proposal: a. Please confirm that there is no limit in the number of references we can submit to prove our capabilities in meeting requirements 1.1 and 1.2. b. Please confirm that proven experiences in leading projects on behalf of International and Financial Institutions, Export Credit Agencies and Commercial	a) We can confirm that there is no limit in the number of references that firms/consortium can submit to prove their capabilities in meeting requirements 1.1 and 1.2. b) Yes, this qualifies.

References are the name, person & contact details of the international organisations that the Firm has worked with, and the GCF will contact these References to do background check of the Firm's performances.
