Position description

The Green Climate Fund is currently seeking an exceptional candidate to undertake the position of Green and Resilient Cities Specialist, who will add value to on-going GCF urban sector interventions and development as well as the pipeline of projects by providing technical expertise in low carbon and resilient urban development, supporting the GCF objective of helping developing countries make a paradigm shift toward low emission and climate resilient development pathway.

Duties and responsibilities

- Support the Secretariat's on-going work in developing countries and their cities towards building capacity to generate a pipeline of viable green and resilient urban infrastructure projects. Cities need to focus on two issues in relation to implementing investments generally and green & resilient investments. Cities need to be able to:
 - Tap a broad base of finance for these investments; and
 - Identify and tap appropriate funding in order to repay any debt financing and support related operation and maintenance costs recovery in full.
- Support to the development of projects that are 'green' and 'resilient', and to decisions as to whether to finance them and how, and on how to fund them, which is the need to define the criteria on which the projects will be assessed.

Expected experience and qualifications

- Solid level of technical knowledge and a minimum of 5 years of experience on climate change in these specific thematic areas (urban resilience, green cities, municipal finance);
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in English are essential for this position; knowledge of another UN language an advantage.
